The Wolfe Tones Club which heads into the 21st Century is a vibrant and thriving one. We provide gaelic games and associated activities for over 250 of our young people, from Under 8s right up to not-so-young adults! Sixteen different teams, for boys and girls, men and women, now wear the Kildress jersey and we plan to increase that number.

All those players and participants are offered facilities at Gortacladdy that are as good as any. If we were to start from scratch, it would take well over £1m to build what we have there.
